I am requesting \$580,694 in funding for the Antioch Downtown Improvement in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Antioch, located at 874 Main Street, Antioch, IL 60002. The funding would be used for building sidewalks on Main Street south to Orchard and on Lake Street east from Toft Street to Main Street.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it facilitates – the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or installation of public works, facilities, and site or other improvements, as well as because it facilitates special projects directed to the removal of material and architectural barriers which restrict the mobility and accessibility of elderly and handicapped persons. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(1)(2) and 5305(a)(5).
