I am requesting \$500,000 in funding for Grandville Avenue Quiet Zone in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Gurnee located at 325 N. O'Plaine Road Gurnee, IL 60031. The funding would be used for a Quiet Zone at the IL Route 41 off ramp for Granville Avenue at-grade railroad crossing to enhance public safety and improvetraffic operations. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve safety at the railroad crossing for both truck traffic and motorists while enhancing the quality of life for nearby residents.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 22907 of title 49 of the United States code.
