Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$8,800,675 in funding for the Village of Winnetka - South of Willow Road Stormwater Conveyance Project in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Winnetka, located at 510 Green Bay Road Winnetka, IL 60093. The funding would be used to replace stormwater conveyance with larger sized pipes that can successfully accommodate up to a 100-year rainstorm and get the water to newly constructed storage vaults. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help solve a chronic Village flooding issue that has seen periodic floods for the past 100 years, causing damage to public infrastructure and individual homes.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
